Contest Rules

The Montreal City of Glass photography contest is organised by Board of Directors of the Montreal Museums, and will take place from February 1st to December 31st, 2010.

Who can participate?

The contest is open internationally, to young audiences between the ages of 10 and 15 years of age, anywhere in the world.

What is the theme of the contest?

The theme chosen for this contest is "Montreal City of Glass".

How you can participate?

Just send a picture in digital format (jpeg) high resolution to the following email address [**info@museesmontreal.org**](mailto:info@museesmontreal.org)

You must indicate your full name, age at the moment of picture sent, address, email and telephone, name of your school as well as a name short description (three (3) lines max) on the photo.

Participants must submit only one photograph.

Technical Specifications

- 1 single photograph per contestant
- Photograph color or black and white
- Photographs should be made from digital medium
- The photo must have a minimum of 1000 KB and 5000 KB maximum
- No photo montage is accepted



Participation and Drawing Deadlines

There are 3 periods during the year 2010:

First contest period : : February 1st to April 30th, 2010
Participation Deadline : April 30th, 12 Am (midnight)
Winning Photo chosen : May 4th, 2010 at 4 pm.

Second contest period : May 1st to September 30th, 2010
Participation Deadline: September 30th at 12 am (midnight)
Winning Photo chosen : October 15th, 2010 at 4 pm.

Third contest period : October 1st to December 31st, 2010
Participation Deadline: December 31st, 2010 at 12am (midnight)
Winning Photo chosen : January 15th, 2011 at 4pm.

The Grand Prizewinner of the year for this first edition will be notified on January 15th, 2011 à 4pm. The winner will be chosen among all the participants.

The contest winners will be displayed on our website www.cityofglassmontreal.com.

Each winner will be notified by email or by regular mail of its designation and will receive his or her prize by regular mail.

Selection criteria for the Jury

A jury of photography professionals and Board of Montreal Museum Directors members will designate the winners for each drawing. The criteria of selection retained will be :

- Originality and impact of photography
- Relevance to the theme "Montreal City of Glass '.
- Photographic processing (placing in the point, framing, contrast, etc.)
